

Red Bridge United Methodist Church Early Childhood Center Registration Q and A

Q. When and where is ECC's registration?

A. ECC's registration begins *Thursday, February 18, 2010 at 8:00am*. Alumni and current in house families will register first. New families will be able to register immediately following the in-house and alumni families. There will be two lines formed: one for in-house/alumni and one for new families. You will register in our Family Life Center. Red Bridge United Methodist Church is located at 636 E. 117th Street Kansas City, MO 64131. Our number is 816-942-4262. Website: www.RedBridgeECC.com. Q. What do I need to bring to registration?

A. You will need to bring your completed registration packet. If you do not have the packet, you can pick one up in the office or get it from our website at www.RedBridgeECC.com. Additionally, you will need to bring a check for your registration fees.

Q. How much does it cost to register a child at ECC?

A. The cost is \$140 for students who are new to ECC. Returning students pay \$100. Make checks payable to: *ECC*.

Q. What does my registration fee pay for?

A. Your registration fee goes towards our in-house field trips, Gymboree, the music program, and special events such as Dad's Night and Fall Fun Night. This fee also covers the cost of art supplies and other consumable materials we use during the school year.

Q. How much is the monthly tuition for 2010-2011?

Q. Does the school need a copy of my child's shot record?

A. Missouri has a Medical Examination Report form that all students must have on file in the office before the first day of school. In addition to your child's shot record, it states that your child is healthy and able to participate in a preschool program. It must be signed by a physician. Copies of this form are available on our website or in the Director's office.

Q. If my child is returning to ECC, do I need to fill the medical form out again?

A. No, we will keep your medical records on file from year to year. If there is any change in your child's health history, please notify us in the office.

Q. Does the school offer scholarships?

A. Yes, we offer partial scholarships to families that need help financially. All scholarship information will remain completely confidential. You can request an application from Miss Leslie in the office or get it from our website at www.RedBridgeECC.com.

Q. Am I guaranteed a space in a class if I am an in-house family?

A. If you register on the morning of February 18, we promise in-house families a spot for the following school year. Please understand that class sizes are limited and you may have to be flexible with your days. We cannot guarantee that you will get your first choice of classes or days.
